Tour Itinerary

June 21 / Fri - Depart Chicago for Krakow, via Warsaw.

June 22 / Sat - Warsaw - Częstochowa - KRAKÓW En route from Warsaw to Kraków, we will make a brief stop in Częstochowa to visit the historic Basilica of the miraculous Black Madonna, patroness of Poland. After checking in at our hotel in Kraków's we will enjoy a Welcome Dinner in one of historic Old Town's atmospheric restaurants.(D)

June 23 / Sun - KRAKÓW This morning you may wish to join your tour host for church services in St. Mary's Basilica before the stunning high altar of Medieval master wood carver Wit Stwosz. In the afternoon we will visit Wawel Castle, the Coronation Cathedral and other historic sites. You may wish to enjoy dinner in one of Old Town's many historic restaurants or enjoy an optional cultural performance. (B, L)

June 24 / Mon - KRAKÓW Today we will visit the home of Jan Matejko, Poland's famous master painter of historic painting and view his works at the National Museum in the Gothic Sukiennice Cloth Hall.This evening we will officially launch our "Bridal Excursion" with a Medieval style banquet, complete with period entertainment and an informal lecture on Princess Jadwiga and Jagiellonian Poland. (B, D)

June 25 / Tues - PRAGUE Our historic journey begins as we depart for Bohemia and Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. We will have lunch en route and a group dinner in one of Prague's atmospheric Old Town restaurants. (B, D)

June 26 / Wed - PRAGUE Our introduction to Medieval Prague includes touring Old Town, St. Vitas Cathedral and other sites. We will be treated to a special sightseeing tour as we board a specially chartered antique trolley - complete with Czech Folk Music and tankards of refreshing Czech pilsner. Our taste of lively Czech traditions continues this evening with a folklore dinner and entertainment in an old country inn on the city's outskirts. (B, D)

June 27 / Thur - PRAGUE Today we will spend some time shopping and enjoying a Medieval Brewery Tour and Lunch. This evening you may wish to have dinner on your own or enjoy an optional cultural performance of the Prague Symphony or *Don Giovanni* at the world renowned National Marionette Theatre. (B, L)

June 28 / Fri - Česky Krumlov / ERDING After breakfast we depart for lunch and sightseeing in Česky Krumlov, one of Europe's most beautiful late Medieval and Renaissance towns. We continue to Bavaria, check in to our hotel and relax at a group dinner. (B, D)

June 29 / Sat - Landshut / ERDING

Today we travel the short distance to Landshut, the site of the Royal Wedding events. We will have time to sightsee, shop and attend a performance of Medieval entertainment. In the evening we will visit partake in a special Medieval dinner, complete with lively costumed reinactors, entertainment, mirth and drink. (B, D)

June 30/ Sun - Landshut / ERDING Today is the Royal Wedding Day! This morning you can opt to visit the courtyard of Trausnitz Castle for a presentation of Medieval Pagentry, then join the entire group for a special lunch in Old Town. After lunch, we will assume our reserved seats in the bleachers lining the streets of Old Town to greet Princess Jadwiga and her retinue - numbering in the thousands - all attired in Medieval finery. Tonight we will assemble at the Tournament Grounds to take our seats as we cheer for our favorite knights in the Royal Wedding Tournament. Dinner is on your own in Old Town. (B, L)

July 1 / Mon - Neuschwanstein / ERDING

After breakfast, we travel to the Bavarian Alps to tour picturesque Neuschwanstein Castle. Our afternoon will be reserved for shopping and strolling the historic streets of Landshut. This evening, we conclude our Royal Wedding Celebrations with a "Poprawiny" - our farewell banquet in an atmospheric Bavarian Hoffbrau. (B, D). July 2 / Tue - Munich After checking out of our hotel, we bid our Medieval friends "Do Widzenia - Auf Wiedersehen" as we transfer to Munich Airport for our flight home.
